Dear General Canine:

I submit herewith my report on SCAMP 1953. It is complete save for certain budgetary details not yet available and a few research reports yet to be finished. Some of the latter involve computational procedures which, as in 1952, can be carried out at the Institute for Numerical Analysis during the academic year.
