In my opinion the \$100,000, would be well spent if we actually receive all the benefits contemplated. However, I suggest that an initial sum, for example, \$25,000, be paid on signing the contract, to be followed by one, two, or three additional payments of like amount, depending upon whether a "deal" with a maximum of \$50,000, or \$75,000, or \$100,000 would be required to make the deal, and contingent upon faithful performance of the contract, including delivery of an acceptable machine and the acceptance of the services of an American technician to work with the during the construction of the machine.
