MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHIEF SIGNAL OFFICER:

SUBJECT: Installation of Secure Teletypewriter Facilities Between
The Military Intelligence Division and the Department of
State.

1. It is requested that action be initiated, in conjunction with the Chief, Army Security Agency, to install private line teletypewriter facilities, with appropriate security equipment to handle Central Intelligence Group messages classified as high as Top Secret, between the Department of State (Mr. Donald Edgar's office, Room 108 State Department Building, 17th Street and Pennsylvania Ave.) and the Military Intelligence Division (G-2 Message Center, Room 2 D 841, Pentagon Building). Installation of this equipment is a military necessity and is justified by the volume of traffic which will flow over such facilities.

2. Cleared personnel will be made available by the Central Intelligence Group for training by personnel of your office in the operation of the above mentioned equipment.

3. It is requested that the installation of this equipment be completed by 15 March 1946.
