Subject: Delineation of Categories of COMINT.

MEMORANDUM FOR THE MEMBERS OF USCIB:

Subject: Implementation of Appendix "B" (Categorization).

Reference: USCIB 13.7/35, dated 20 September 1954.

1. In reply to the reference, this office has been informed via SUKLO that ISIB (1) agrees that the categorization lists enclosed with the reference form a suitable starting point for implementation of categories under new Appendix "B"; (2) accepts the U.S. proposal for a general change of codewords coincident with the introduction of categories, subject to postponement of the effective date until 1 January 1955 (this delay is occasioned by a U.K. error in the selection of codewords); (3) concurs in the USCIB view that the introduction of categories will be the final step in the full implementation of revised Appendix "B".



In view of the circumstances described, this office has informed U.K. authorities of U.S. acceptance of their proposal for a postponement in effective date of introduction of categories and new codewords until 1 January 1955.
