
~~SECRET - SECURITY INFORMATION~~MEMORANDUM FOR THE MEMBERS OF USCIBEC:

Subject: Downgrading of Classification of USCIB
Directives Numbers 1, 2, and 3.

1. In accordance with the policy of USCIB which is to classify charts and descriptions of the organization of USCIB CONFIDENTIAL, and to classify the fact of collaboration with the U.K. SECRET, it is recommended that USCIB Directives Numbers 1 and 2 be downgraded to CONFIDENTIAL and that USCIB Directive Number 3 be downgraded to SECRET.

2. Attention is invited to the heading of paragraph 5c of USCIB Directive Number 3. Action is being initiated to obtain approval for downgrading to SECRET the fact of collaboration with the other countries concerned. Since specific mention of only the U.K. is made it would appear that the classification of USCIB Directive Number 3 need not be higher than SECRET.

3. The recommendations contained in paragraphs 1 and 2, above, are being scheduled for consideration at the next regular meeting of USCIBEC, 17 July 1953.
