

1. Your 700/1 ratio of dollar spending is our best estimate of value of Comdant during WWII.
2. It is reasonable to accept this as an ~~estimate~~ <sup>admittedly unreliable</sup> estimate of the value of at least the research effort of AFSA; if this is successful,
3. AFSA's research budget is said to be of the order of magnitude of  $\$1.4 \times 10^7$  per yr.
4.  $\$1.4 \times 10^7 \times 700 = \$10^{10}$  per yr.
5. As an off the cuff guess  $\$10^{10}$  is about 5% or 1% of the <sup>total</sup> national <sup>annual</sup> income - this may be a very poor estimate.
6. There are about 50 military men on active duty with rank at least 3 stars & comparably many civilians in super-grades. This is an unreliable estimate.
7. AFSA does not have a fair percentage of these.
8. AFSA has no charter authority to protect this tremendously important portion & authoritative control.
